

**Specific* access requirements
for the MASTER in MANAGEMENT (120 credits)**
for holders of a university degree
of the FWB or Flemish Community

CONDITIONS:

- To hold a **first cycle university degree** (a 180 credit-Bachelor's Degree), recognized by the FWB (formerly French Community of Belgium) or by the Flemish Community containing the following 108 credits:

Economics	18 credits
Management	27 credits
Quantitative methods	24 credits
Human and Social sciences (incl. Law)	24 credits
Languages **	15 credits

** An insufficient number of credits in foreign languages may be offset by evidence of passing an English test at level B2 of the CEFR (Common European Framework).

- Proficiency in the teaching languages of the programme.

REMARKS :

- Holders of a first cycle UCL degree in computer science, human and social sciences, sociology and anthropology, information and communication and political science, who have taken the preparatory minor in Management, have access to the Master in Management by adding prerequisites courses up to 15 credits.
- Holders of a first cycle degree who have not gained all the prerequisites credits detailed here above, will have to complete their master' study programme by adding the missing credits up to a limit of 60 credits.
- Holders of a degree, who are missing more than the 60 required prerequisites credits, cannot have access to Master 120 in Management.
- Holders of a second cycle university degree (= master), who are respecting the conditions mentioned here above and who have followed at least 45 course credits, at master's level, equivalent to the courses of the Master [120] in Management of the Louvain School of Management, may obtain, in one year, the Master [120] in Management
