The Masters in Advanced European Business and Economic Policy aims to prepare students for managerial positions in European affairs.

The Masters programme is organised jointly by the Louvain School of Management and the Institute of European Studies of the Saint-Louis University - Brussels.

#### Why choose this programme?

The programme is based on high academic standards with highly specialised professors and practitioners working on EU affairs

The programme includes not only state of the art academic and technical knowledge but also updated case studies so as to provide useful information and methodology on current issues for those who are to be involved in field activities.

The geographical proximity of Brussels, the centre of the European institutions and lobbying enhances the business and policy-oriented aspects of the programme with the participation of field experts from EU institutions, business, NGOs or consultants in European affairs.

Events such as visits of EU institutions, NGOs and think-tanks as well as attending EU affairs conferences will be organized throughout the year to familiarize our students with the Brussels EU bubble. A recreational team building event is also part of this programme.



#### Entry requirements

#### 1. Language:

- TOEFL iBT with minimum level of 89
- Or IELTS with minimum level of 6.5
- Or ITACE with minimum level of B2

#### 2. University Degree:

- Holding a University Masters in Economics, Business or Management
- or holding a University Masters and having obtained in her/his university curriculum 50 credits in economics, business or management and 10 credits in law
- or holding a relevant University Masters. In this
  case, students will have to follow an additional
  programme of up to 15 credits in economics
  and management that will be added to the
  standard programme of Advanced Master in
  European Business & Economic Policy

#### 3. Application deadlines

International student applications can now be submitted.

Non-European students have until **30 April** to apply online

EU students until 31 August.

### Organisation and content

This one-year programme starts in mid-September and is divided in two semesters. The first semester starts in September and ends with the January examinations. The second semester starts in February and ends with the June examinations.
